Please read the following carefully:

Annie's Orphans specifies the criteria for fostering and decides on appropriate matches between dogs to be fostered and eligible foster homes. Foster care volunteers may always refuse any specific request for any reason. Prior to the foster assignment, AO will provide written disclosure (hard copy, email or text) of any diseases, injuries or abnormalities of the specific animal to be fostered, if any of these apply. AO will inform of any medical treatments to be administered, anticipated length of foster placement, the objectives of each particular placement (restoring to health, rearing to adoptable age, socialization, etc.), and any other expectations or known restrictions.

The foster dog is expected to be kept properly cared for, safe and secure. Further, the foster dog is expected to be returned to AO immediately upon request and is under the exclusive authority of AO with respect to approval and action toward a potential adoption. AO retains possession of all animals placed in foster care, and will make all placement/adoption decisions to be made on behalf of fostered dogs.

I agree that, while fostering for AO, I will not take the foster dog to dog parks and will not allow my foster dog to be off-leash in any non-secured areas. *AO foster dogs and puppies must be supervised at all times when outdoors*. I also agree that, for the duration of the fostering assignment, I will not take the foster dog outside of the general area.

I have carefully read and understand the statements within this application and waiver. I certify that all the information contained in this application is true and correct. I understand that, although AO takes reasonable care to screen animals for foster care placement, it makes no guarantees relating to the animal's health, behavior or actions. I understand that activities involving dogs/puppies can involve the possibility of harm, even serious injury, through such things as being scratched, bitten, jumped on, dragged or knocked over, and I am voluntarily agreeing to assume any and all risks for any injury that may occur, as well as any loss, liability, damage, cost or expense which may be incurred as a result of any injury. I understand that I receive foster care animals at my own risk and can decline to accept any animal for which AO has asked me to provide care. I acknowledge that AO is not responsible for any property damage or personal injury suffered by me, members of my household - including my own animals - or any third parties during a foster placement, and I assume liability for the provision of adequate controls to prevent such damage or injury. In consideration of the above, I hereby waive, release, and discharge any and all claims and damages for said injury and/or property damage. This release is intended to discharge, in advance, Annie's Orphans Dog Shelter, its Director, Board, Staff, Volunteers or Agents, including their heirs, successors and assignees from and against any and all liabilities, actions, claims, demands, or expenses arising from or in any way connected with my participation as a foster. I agree that my participation is of a voluntary nature, involving no expectation of compensation, and I am not covered under any medical insurance, worker's comp or property insurance associated with Annie's Orphans.

I understand and agree to adhere to all relevant local/county/state zoning and animal control codes and ordinances.

I hereby grant AO permission to use, without payment or other consideration, my likeness – which I may submit to AO in photograph or video – in any and all of its advertising or collateral materials.
